


Bank Substitution

*Increased Bank Substitution Support
October 3, 2025*

SameGoal supports the use of bank values, which allow users to store frequently used text to avoid having to rewrite common content.

For a long time, these bank values have supported name and pronoun substitution, enabling document authors to use the same content for different students because the student's first name and pronouns can automatically substitute into the bank value.

For example, in Jane Smith's document, if you had stored **[name] will tie his shoes** as a bank value, the text will be converted to **Jane will tie her shoes**.

💡 Tip For each type of substitution other than pronouns, the desired element should be written with the square brackets [] around it.
