

## **Graduation Codes**

A new column has been added to the **Anticipated Graduation** report (**Special Education** > **Administration** > **Anticipated Graduation**) that displays the anticipated graduation code for a student.

This code is based on responses to the **Foundation High School Program** questions in Section 5 of the IEP and SP, and reflects TSDS/PEIMS data element E0806 DiplomaType.
