


Version History

In the coming weeks, we will be rolling out an update that expands event tracking even further.

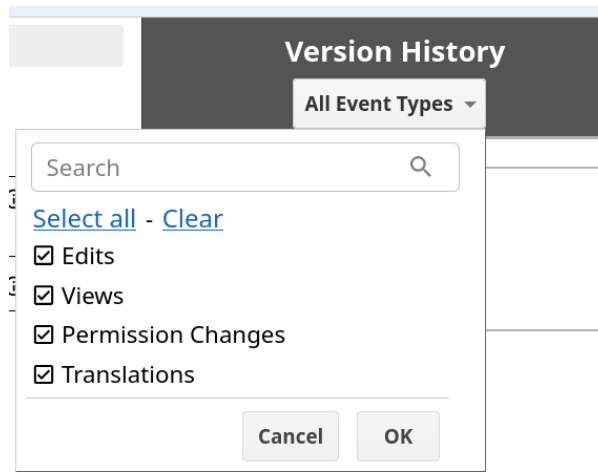
With this update, the Version History panel will also track:

- Document share events
- Permission changes
- When a parent/guardian opens the document share email
- When someone views the document
