

Section 504 Forms

Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 is a federal civil rights law that prohibits discrimination against persons with disabilities. Because enforcement is at the federal rather than state level (the U.S. Department of Education, Office for Civil Rights (OCR) enforces Section 504), few state education agencies provide model Section 504 forms (including TEA).

SameGoal includes Section 504 Forms developed by the "Equity & Civil Rights" division of the Washington Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction. These forms are customized in SameGoal to address state-specific legislative requirements and more closely align with form layouts Texas districts are accustomed to.
