



**sg-sftp.sh** is a script recommended for routine, automatic uploads.

- Supported platforms: Mac<sup>™</sup> and Linux<sup>™</sup>
- Connection requirements: Use your OpenSSH-style public key (**id\_rsa.pub**) and OpenSSH-style private key (**id\_rsa**) to connect.

**Steps** To use SG-SFTP:

- 1. Download **sg-sftp.sh**
- 2. Open a command terminal. Change directory to the location where **sg-sftp.sh** is saved.
- 3. Run the script from the command line. Example: jsmith@debian:~/samegoal\$ ./sg-sftp.sh
- 4. Scroll up in the terminal to read the instructions. Enter the prompts.
